On behalf of the Council for International Exchange of Scholars, I should like to congratulate you on your selection by the Board of Foreign Scholarships for an award under the Mutual Educational Exchange Program. As you may know, the Council assists the Department of State with the administration of the exchange program for lecturers and research scholars. We are pleased to welcome you to the United States and to assure you of our interest in helping make your visit a worthwhile experience.

This Council is the agency responsible for all matters relating to your sponsorship and academic program. Members of the staff will be glad to assist you in any way possible, either before or after your arrival in the United States. If there should be any significant change in your plans, such as your arrival date or university affiliation, it is important that you obtain prior approval from the Council. Unless other arrangements are approved in advance, it is assumed that you will carry out the program outlined in your application.

It is requested that you apply for an Exchange Visitor visa under Exchange Program No. G-1-5 for which the necessary Form DSP-66 will be provided with the Terms of Award for your grant. Since the Council has no authority to make travel arrangements, it is important that, prior to departure from your home country, you discuss with the office which issues your grant any questions relating to return transportation or shipment of baggage.

Your attention is called to the attached Arrival Notification Form. It is important that this form be completed and mailed to the Council immediately upon your arrival in the United States. The information requested on this form is essential for the Council's records of your immigration status, as well as for other administrative details, including the sickness and accident insurance provided as a benefit of your grant.

We hope that you will be able to carry out your academic program to your complete satisfaction and to obtain maximum value from your visit to the United States. If you should plan a visit to Washington, we would be very pleased if you could call at the Council's office, 11 Dupont Circle, third floor.
